RE: Jandowae Timbertown Festival - June Long Weekend, 2010

On behalf of the Timbertown Festival Committee I am writing to seek your support of the 2010 festival which as you may already know is a significant event on the regional calendar, and one which has gained national acclaim over the years that it has been successfully staged in Jandowae.

Our committee believe that the 2010 event is shaping up to be just as exciting and action packed as festival goers have become accustomed to, with exciting new highlights featured on the program to draw additional interest.

### Timbertown Festival Opportunities:

This year the committee is trying to get as many local groups involved in the festival as possible. Your organization is invited to be involved in the 2010 Timbertown Festival, there are several options available to you and keep in mind you can participate on more than one day of the festival. At present the committee is seeking:

Saturday - **George Street Markets 10:00am - 4:30pm**

**Food Stalls:** (It will be Winter time) donuts, hot chips/wedges, nachos, hot dogs, fairy floss, baked potatoes, drinks stall - hot and cold drinks, soup/stews stall, pies/quiches/sausage rolls stall.

The Top Pub has the lunch time booked to host a BBQ and Yabby Races.

Other Stalls: All other market stalls are welcome also i.e: craft, lollies/jams etc.

**Rodeo Extravaganza from 5:00pm - 12:00am**

**Food Stalls:** BBQs, donuts, hot chips/wedges, nachos, hot dogs, fairy floss, baked potatoes, drinks stall - hot and cold drinks, soup/stews stall, pies/quiches/sausage rolls stall.

Hopefully there will be wood fired pizzas available as well as a campfire cookout operating.

Sunday - **Lions Park Markets 7:00am - 2:00pm**

Breakfast stalls, morning tea stalls including tea and coffee, BBQs, donuts, hot chips/wedges, nachos, hot dogs, fairy floss, baked potatoes, drinks stall - hot and cold drinks, soup/stews stall, pies/quiches/sausage rolls stall.

Other Stalls: All other market stalls are welcome also e.g: craft, lollies/jams, fresh produce (eggs, fruit etc.)

Markets stall sites are extremely affordable, especially when anticipating a crowd of 2500-3000 over the weekend:

- **Saturday or Sunday Daytime Markets Site Fee: \$17 per day**
- **Saturday and Sunday Daytime Market Site Fee: \$30**
- **Saturday Night Rodeo Extravaganza Site: \$50**  
(includes 2 x free entry tickets to the Rodeo)

### Background Information:

The Jandowae Timbertown Festival is a biannual celebration of the contribution the timber industry has made to the town during its history. Several locally owned and operated timbermills and timber related industries are based in Jandowae and most of the long term local families have strong links to the industry.

The Timbertown Festival is held over the Queen's Birthday long weekend in June every two years and this year (11<sup>th</sup> – 14<sup>th</sup>) will be an especially poignant celebration with the recent closure of Jandowae's last remaining timbermill. The Jandowae community have taken this opportunity to again honour the workers who have participated in the industry and to really expand celebrations to include our vibrant local agricultural, fresh produce, and manufacturing industries. Our festival will also showcase the depth and variety of local talent and community spirit which make our town such a great place to live, work and play in.

### Event Program:

An enormous amount of community consultation has gone into developing the festival program for 2010 and the organizing committee have again sought to ensure that as many local community groups and sporting clubs as possible are able to benefit from the activities planned for the weekend for example:

Fun Run proceeds will go toward Jandowae Swimming Pool improvements;  
Gala Art Show & Auction will be a fundraiser for the Jandowae Kindergarten;  
Craft show proceeds will assist the Jandowae Craft Club and their chosen charities;  
20/20 Bush Bash cricket match proceeds will assist the local cricket teams;  
Golf day will assist the Jandowae Golf Club,  
and the Rodeo will assist the local Heritage and Progress Association's business subcommittee toward funding future community events including the 2012 Timbertown Festival.

We would like to thank you for taking the time to consider our proposal and regardless of whether you are able to contribute towards the festival or not, the Timbertown Festival Committee and Jandowae Community would take great pleasure in extending an invitation to you and your family to come along to Jandowae to experience our culture and participate in the festivities as we celebrate Timbertown 2010!
